- To appoint staff part-time or whole-time for conducting (2) the affairs of the Society and fix remmeration for the staff a pointed and to define their duties and obligations towards the Society. The Seciety can also engage the services of the prominent intellectuals, philosphers, adentists and educationists, part-time or whole-time and fix their remuneration, allowances perquisites and afford them the necessary facilities for the performance of their duties.
